The Hammer-Headed Bat


Shauri is a hammer-headed bat. He is also crazy about soccer! The big game is tomorrow, so Shauri decides to go give his favorite player, Kelechi, a pep talk.

Male hammer-headed bats have a giant nose that lets them make incredibly loud HONK-ing noises. Shauri lands in a tree outside Kelechi's home and begins to cheer Kelechi on. Shauri is a good honker who can deliver 25 super loud HONKs per minute. Shauri HONKs 120 times before the light comes on in the home and Kelechi comes out. How many minutes did it take to wake Kelechi up? Express your answer as a decimal.

Kelechi grabs an apple and throws it towards the noise. "How kind," thinks Shauri. "Kelechi must know that hammer-headed bats love fruit!" Kelechi throws a total of 4 apples, 6 mangos, 3 pineapples, and 12 bananas into the darkness before things quiet down. Each fruit weighs the following amount: apple: 84 grams, mango: 215 grams, pineapple: 907 grams, banana: 118 grams. How many kilograms of fruit did Kelechi throw? Express your answer as a decimal.



Kelechi has just fallen back asleep before the HONK-ing starts back up, louder than ever! Shauri has brought back 99 of his best friends to celebrate Kelechi's generosity. Kelechi yells at them, but it just encourages the hammer-headed bats. "Hooray for Kelechi!" they HONK. Each of the 100 bats eats fruit and HONKs 10 times per minute for the next 4 hours until the sun comes up. How many HONKs does Kelechi get to enjoy?



The next day, Kelechi doesn't score too many goals. In fact, he keeps falling asleep on the field! Normally Kelechi runs 7.56 miles in a game, but today he runs only 1/4 that amount. How many miles does Kelechi manage to run during the game? Express your answer as a decimal.
