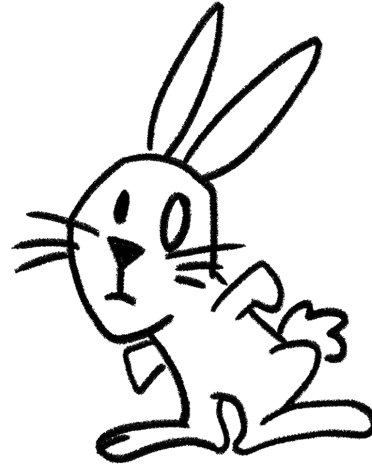
**REMAINDERS AS FRACTIONS**

When you are dividing, you can express your remainder as a fraction. Sometimes, an answer makes more sense when you write it as a mixed fraction... it depends on the question!

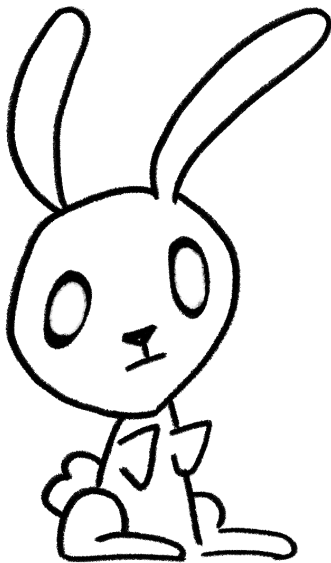
For example:

$$22 \div 7 = 3r1 = 3\frac{1}{7}$$

$$18 \div 5 = 3r3 = 3\frac{3}{5}$$
