The animals are hungry. The ducks stick their head in Tim's picnic basket and start chowing down on candy corn! There is a bag with 232 pieces of candy corn in the picnic basket. The ducks eat all of it! If the 4 ducks divide the corn equally, how many pieces will each duck get?

Tim doesn't notice any of this. He is too busy getting speeding tickets! He gets 14 tickets on his trip. Each ticket is a fine for \$37. How much money does Tim get fined?

Tim has been traveling to Fresno. He started out in Tulsa, which is 1558 miles away. He's traveled 857 miles so far. How much farther does Tim need to go to reach Fresno?
