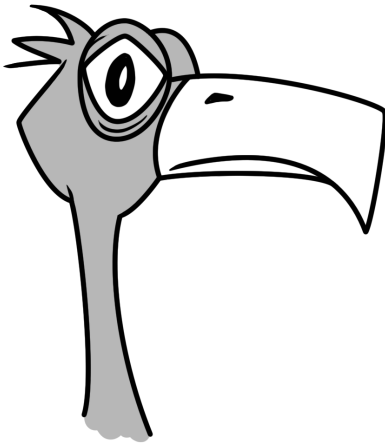


TERROR BIRD

The scientists on Isla Cenozo have done it! They have succeeded in re-creating the legendary Terror Bird of ancient South America! Only the coolest scientists are able to bring back dangerous extinct life forms. Now they can join the club!

Terror Birds used to roam ancient South America. These savage birds could grow up to 10 feet high and loved to feast on flesh! The scientists decide to build a theme park to show off the birds and make money. They want a giant statue that is 10 times as big as a real terror bird in the middle of the park. How tall will the statue be?



Terror birds are messy eaters. After they chow down, they usually leave about $\frac{1}{3}$ of a wildebeest carcass lying around. The scientists have been hauling the bits out and tossing them in the trash. If they were to put the leftovers in the freezer instead, how many wildebeest carcasses would they have after 7 days? Express your answer as a mixed fraction.

The scientists decide to cut costs and start feeding them possums instead. A possum is about $\frac{1}{5}$ of a meal to a terror bird. How many meals can the scientists get out of a box containing 36 possums? Express your answer as a mixed fraction.

The Terror Birds are still hungry, so the scientists run out and buy some frozen pizzas. They will need at least 60 slices to keep the birds happy. The pizzas are cut into 8 slices each. After a light supper, the scientists are left with $7\frac{3}{8}$ pizzas. How many slices are left to feed to the birds? Do you think the birds will be happy with the scientists?

Hunh. The scientists have all gone missing! They left only a few scraps of clothes and some torn notes lying around. The Terror Birds seem happy though. I wonder what happened?!
