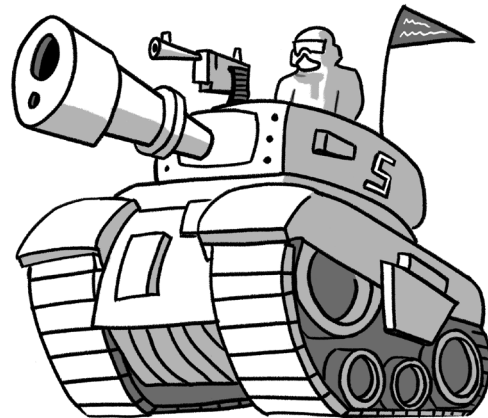
IMPROPER FRACTIONS TO MIXED FRACTIONS

You can look at fractions as a way of saying how something is divided up.
Use division to convert from an improper fraction to a mixed fraction.

For example:

$$\frac{10}{3} = 10 \div 3 = 3\frac{1}{3}$$

$$\frac{25}{5} = 25 \div 5 = 5$$
