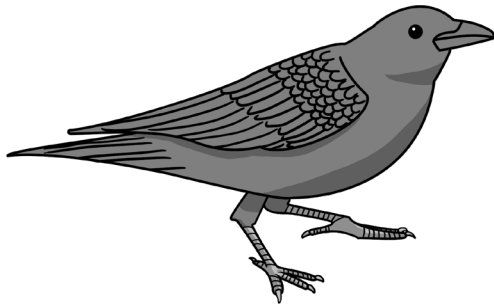


LE TRIOMPHE

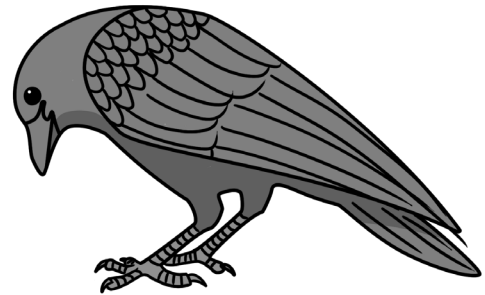
The crows in Paris are in an uproar. Two groups, the Cameron Crows and the Corvid Crew, are vying for the title of “ultimate scrounger.” They decide to have a contest in order to settle things once and for all. Who will triumph?



The first round involves scrounging bags of chips. The crows hang out at a school and wait until lunch time. The children are not very careful with their food, so the crows manage to get a lot of chips! The Cameron Crows are a large group of 20 crows and are able to bring back 14 bags within the time limit. The smaller Corvid Crew, which has only 5 members, brings back 3 bags. The contest will be won by whoever brings back the most chips per crow. Which group is the winner?

Time for round two! One crow lands on the shoulder of a local fruit seller and lets out a loud CAW! The man jumps and drops the box of apples he is carrying. Oops! The other crows scramble to grab as many apples as possible. The Cameron Crows make off with 36 apples while the Corvid Crew gets 12. Which team got the most apples per crow?

The crows decide to turn up the heat. They hatch a scheme to startle tourists into dropping their sandwiches. Once a sandwich hits the ground, another crow will swoop in and grab it! Also, another team of 4 crows, the so-called “Glaughlin Group,” decides to join the action. After some intense sandwich snatching action, the final score is Cameron Crows: 21, Corvid Crew: 6, and Glaughlin Group: 5. Who had the highest score per crow?



The crows are feeling a little bit guilty about their tricks and decide to give back to the community. For their final contest, they decide that they will see how many cigarettes they can get off the street. Some teams also reform, leaving 10 crows in the Cameron Crows, 5 in the Corvid Crew and 6 in the Glaughlin Group. The Cameron Crows keep things simple and make off with an entire carton of 120 cigarettes from a tabac. The Corvid Crew gets 60 by grabbing packs off of café tables. The Glaughlin Group goes “next level” on their commitment to community service and gathers up 72 cigarette butts out of the park. How do the teams compare in terms of cigarettes per crow?
