Hey Kids! Time for a super fun math lesson, courtesy of Math Madness!

MULTIPLICATION BY POWERS OF TEN

When you multiply or divide a number by a power of 10, you can quickly get to an answer by simply shifting the decimal point.

- For multiplication, move it one digit to the right for each power of 10.
- For division, move it to the left for each power of 10. Add zeros when you go past the existing digits.

$$55 \times 100 = 5500$$

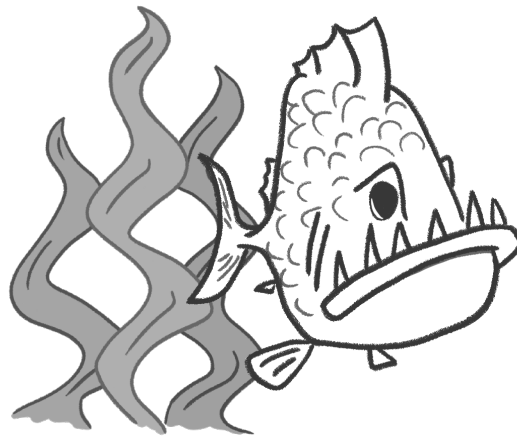
$$5.5 \times 100 = 550$$

$$.055 \times 100 = 5.5$$

$$22 \div 100 = .22$$

$$2.2 \div 100 = .022$$

$$.022 \div 100 = .00022$$

$5 \times 1000 =$

$3.4 \times 10 =$

$.003 \times 100 =$

$1.234 \times 100 =$

$.014 \times 10 =$

$23.27 \times 100 =$

$3 \div 100 =$

$10 \div 10 =$

$125 \div 1000 =$

$99 \div 100 =$

$.58 \div 10 =$
