**DECIMALS TO PERCENTAGES**

Percentages are just decimals that have been multiplied by 100.

Since decimals are always written in powers of 10, you can just move the decimal point two digits to the right, adding zeros if necessary.

Here are some examples:

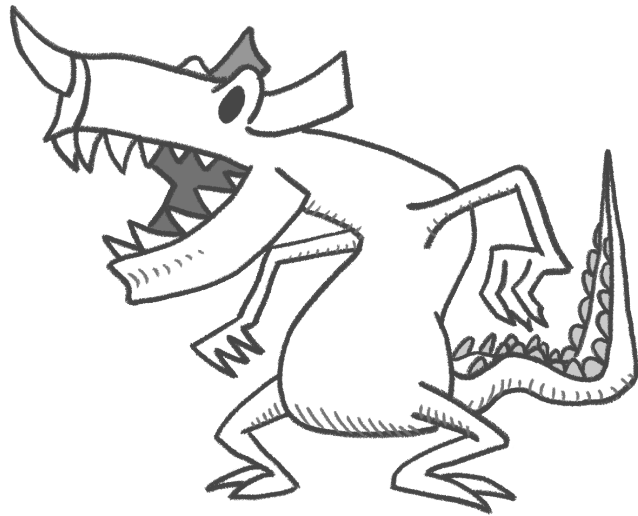
$$.5 = 50\%$$

$$.01 = 1\%$$

$$1.10 = 110\%$$

$$.005 = .5\%$$

$$.75 = 75\%$$
